



MEMORY DVD

Frequently Asked Questions



Q: What's the price?

A: \$10 during registration. That's 60% off the full price! The price will go up to \$20 during the school year and \$25 after graduation. The \$10 price is a special for Registration ONLY; it will never again be this low!

Q: When will the DVD be ready, and how will I get mine?

A: Since it includes clips of Graduation and end-of-year events, the DVD will be available in late June 2011. DVDs can be picked up in the high school's main office. Information will be posted on the WDBC & LOHS websites, in school newsletters, during the daily news show *LO-AM*, and emailed to the address(es) you provide. Be sure to save your receipt!

Q: Is this DVD only for seniors?

A: NO! Some students buy it every year to have a collection of memories of their *entire* high school career, not just one year out of the four. Some elements of the DVD will be mostly meaningful to seniors (such as the graduation highlights), but other parts pertain to everyone (such as the clips of school clubs, freshmen/jv/varsity sports, activities, dances, etc.).

Q: Will events be included in their entirety, like the whole Homecoming game?

A: No, this DVD will feature **highlights** of those events. Some entire events (such as the Homecoming Assembly and some games) can be purchased separately.

Q: Graduation is included?

A: Yes, the DVD will include **highlights** of the event, such as the speakers, procession, and tassel turn, along with candid photos that won't be seen anywhere else. It will NOT include every single student's name being read.

Q: Can you guarantee that every student will be shown on the DVD?

A: No we cannot. We aim to include everyone, but this is different from the print yearbook. The yearbook includes still pictures of nearly all students. This DVD features video & audio highlights of nearly all activities and sports and events from throughout the year. It does NOT include still photos of each individual student.

Q: How long will the DVD be?

A: Approximately 1 ½ - 2 hours.

Q: Can I (or my friends) buy the DVD online instead of in-person?

A: YES. Go online to our website (www.dragonbroadcasting.org), and follow the link to purchase your DVD. The price is \$10 in-person or online until the final day of Registration. After Registration ends, it jumps up to \$20. After Graduation (June 2011), the price is locked at \$25. Many people make the mistake of waiting to buy it later in the year, and therefore they end up paying more; don't make that mistake!

Q: Can I still buy *past* DVDs?

A: Yes, the 2008, 2009, & 2010 DVDs are still available for purchase at the full price of \$25. You can buy a copy online at www.dragonbroadcasting.org, or you may purchase a copy in-person at Registration and take it home that day.

Q: Is this a fundraiser for a school group/club?

A: Yes, all proceeds benefit the Dragon Broadcasting program and students. We are very fortunate to have a tv studio and editing facilities, and the money raised from this project helps us remain current with software and equipment.

Q: Who is "Dragon Broadcasting"?

A: "Dragon Broadcasting", or WDBC, started in 1970 at Lake Orion High School. It began as a radio class, and now it has developed into Michigan's top high school video & broadcasting program (ranked #1 in four of the last 5 school years by the Michigan Interscholastic Press Association). "Dragon Broadcasting" refers to the video/broadcast program & productions at LOHS. We offer over a half-dozen courses, and you can read about them at www.dragonbroadcasting.org.
